- 2 hrs employment per week for each semester (summer 2015, fall 2015, and/or spring 2016) for approximately \$275 stipend per term. Continuation to future terms is negotiable
- **Must make a commitment for full semester.** Must attend a monthly organizational session with coordinator, program, faculty or mentors. Must be able to attend training and kick-off session at the start of spring classes.
- Must provide a faculty member name as a reference & a copy of your summer and fall 2015 class schedules
- Responsibilities will include: mentoring up to 6 students, communicating with students via phone and email, participating in group social & academic activities (limited # throughout each term)
