**Become a COMPASS Mentor: A Rewarding Experience that Pays**

The mission of the **COMPASS program** is to increase the number of UCF students pursuing a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) discipline. To facilitate the successful accomplishment of this mission COMPASS offers students opportunities for career exploration and experiential learning in STEM the first two years of their college career.

Required Credentials, Skills and Expectations:

- Good academic standing STEM undergraduate student
- Should be sophomore, junior or senior standing
- Successful experience in math and science courses preferred
- 2 hrs employment per week for each semester (Summer and Fall) for approximately \$275 stipend per term. Continuation to future terms is negotiable. Summer employment is based on mentor availability and is not a requirement to be a Fall mentor.
- **Must make a commitment for full semester.** Must attend bi-weekly one hour organizational sessions with coordinator and mentors. Must be able to attend all training sessions prior to the end of spring classes and kick-off events at the start of each semester.

Training Dates:

- Feb. 28-March 2: 2 hour business meeting (must attend 1 of the 3 sessions)
  - March 4: 5 hour (Tentative time 12-5 pm) Mentor Training off campus
  - March 25: 1-4 pm, Mentor Training (ropes course)
  - April 8: 8 am-5 pm, Formal Training (EXCEL/COMPASS Center)
- Must provide a faculty member name as a reference.
  - Responsibilities include: mentoring approximately 6 undecided students who are exploring STEM majors during their first term at UCF. This entails communicating with students via phone, email and in person bi-weekly meetings and participating in group social & academic activities (limited # throughout each term).
